

# 2020 Better Business Challenge Mini-Grant Application

Helping businesses achieve their efficiency and sustainability goals.

The Better Business Challenge, in partnership with the City of Charlottesville Economic Development's ACE program, is pleased to offer a mini-grant opportunity to assist City businesses in need of energy efficiency improvements. If your income qualifies, you will receive additional Challenge assistance and your organization may be awarded a grant for energy efficiency goods and/or services.

The goal of the Challenge is to help businesses increase their energy efficiency and sustainability throughout daily operations, as well as reap cost savings opportunities, enhance their brand, and engage in a community-wide effort with some great FREE publicity.

To qualify, the business owner must be low to moderate income, as defined by the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Easy Next Steps:

- 1. Complete entire application by November 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
- 2. Submit application and supplementary materials via email or mail.
- 3. Challenge staff will complete an informal phone/in-person interview.
- 4. Selected businesses will receive an award notice by February 2021; Recipients will receive further instruction upon award notice.

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for this mini-grant program, applicants must:

- Have a business license in the City of Charlottesville
- Be a for-profit business or a B corporation
- Be able to provide documentation to meet income requirements
- Complete entire application and submit to the Community Climate Collaborative
